Boise, Idaho – The Boise Rescue Mission Lighthouse in Nampa will receive a new heating system for the building from Advanced Heating and Cooling of Meridian, free of charge including the installation. The work will begin Monday, 12/31 and should be completed the same day. The furnace gift is a part of the Company's "Warm Hearts, Warm Homes" program providing 6 needy families with a new furnace.

Mission Director Bill Roscoe applied to the company for the new furnace as he learned of the company's holiday project. "As I spoke with the people at Advanced Heating, and explained the emergency shelter program of the Mission, they decided that the Lighthouse was a good place for them to make the investment of a new furnace" Roscoe said. "Needless to say, we are delighted!" he added.

The furnace being replaced is over twenty years old and has required several service calls during the past year. Roscoe said that a new furnace was planned for in 2007, but funds simply were not available to do the work.

Mr. Bob Ginkel of Advanced Heating and Air said that helping the Mission with this need was an excellent opportunity for the Company to give back to the Community. "I think that the Rescue Mission does an excellent job providing meals and shelter to the homeless and this new furnace will provide the heat that they need for the Lighthouse shelter." Said Ginkel.

The new furnace is a TRANE with 120,000 BTU input. It is a super efficient model using less fuel and losing less heat than the model being replaced. It comes with a five year warranty on parts and a 20 year warranty on the heat exchanger.

"The TRANE company's motto is "It's hard to stop a TRANE". I think our motto will be, "It's hard to thank Advanced Heating and Cooling" enough for this great help!" Said Roscoe.
