BOISE RESCUE MISSION MOVING OPERATIONS

Boise Rescue Mission Ministries has had its home at 520 Front Street since 1971, and that building has served Boise's homeless well. Now, the Mission has relocated to 575 S., 13th Street, the former Community House building. Now called the "River of Life" this building is fully owned and operated by Boise Rescue Mission Ministries, and will be the location of all of the Mission's shelter, feeding, counseling, and other services for homeless men in Boise.

That full transition is now possible due to the completion of the new kitchen at the River of Life building, which will enable staff there to prepare and serve an estimated 340 meals a day in the coming winter months.

This Saturday, October 27th at 2:00 p.m., Boise Rescue Mission Ministries will officially open the new kitchen at the River of Life. The community and the media are invited to join Reverend Bill Roscoe, Pastors Montie Ralston and Bob Hover, Bruce Chatterton, and other friends of the Mission for this exciting occasion and to take a tour of the River of Life Mission and the new construction.
