Boise Rescue Mission has been chosen as the beneficiary of locally donated suits from the drive. Mayor Tom Dale will hand off his donated suit to a resident of the Mission for use in an upcoming job interview. Mayor Dale sets an example for the Treasure Valley community to step up and help those less fortunate in their efforts to re-enter the workforce.

Currently, Boise Rescue Mission is serving 950+ meals per day in three Treasure Valley homeless shelters. This is no surprise when, according to the Idaho Department of Labor, Idaho unemployment reached 8.8% in July
