

Boise Rescue Mission Ministries' New Life Program

The New Life Program is the Mission's 1-2 year drug and alcohol addiction recovery program. It provides discipleship, accountability, and a Bible - based curriculum of studies and classes to help men and women end their addictions and gain the tools to stay drug-free.

The program started in 1996, and since then over two hundred men and women have graduated and moved on to build productive, successful lives.

Upon graduation the Mission is able to offer transitional housing for women and men in Boise, and for men in Nampa. Graduates can live in the "Next Step" apartments for a nominal program transitional housing fee while they build credit and savings, and look for permanent housing.

Program Capacity:

City Light - 20 if only single women, otherwise - 16 women and 11 children

Lighthouse - 24

River of Life - 30

Length: The time it takes to complete the program varies by individual, averaging from 1 to 2 years.

Cost: The New Life Program is completely funded by generous members of the community, and is free for participants. The cost for one person to go through the program is about \$33,945.

What you can do:

- **Mentor** - Christian men and women are needed to come alongside program members and counsel them through their program
- **Tutor** - Many program members work towards their GEDs, and you can help them with their studies
