FROM THE PRESIDENT & CEO



Dear Mission Friends,

The past year has been one of incredible blessings from God as we continue to serve His people. The new Nampa facility, Valley Women and Children's Shelter, has been very busy, with unusually high numbers of children staying with us at night. I thank God that we are able to serve these moms and kids and we pray that each of them will find their way back to independent living.

The new and greatly improved Lighthouse Rescue Mission has served homeless men and provided an increasing number of meals to our neighbors. This past January, we officially opened the Veterans Dorm, setting aside 12 beds for homeless veterans interested in regaining their independence.

In Boise, River of Life Rescue Mission and City Light Home for Women & Children are providing the same life-changing services that we have provided for over 57 years. The results are hundreds of people finding faith and hope in God and becoming productive, contributing members of our community.

Never forget that your support is what makes all of this possible! You are the reason for the existence and work of Boise Rescue Mission Ministries. We do not seek or receive any government funds, depending solely on God and our community for all of our support. You have a part in everything that we do, and you share in the blessing with us.

Two years ago, we celebrated with a person who, after being homeless, had achieved success that was truly extraordinary. This person had a desire to serve in law enforcement and earned a Criminal Justice degree from Boise State. With that, this person became a member of a county sheriff's office and last year joined a local police department as a patrolman. We've had other people go on to be productive, responsible workers, like crew leaders, managers, executive assistants, and public sector employees, but never before have we had one become a law enforcement officer.

What an amazing outcome for someone who once had little hope and many barriers to overcome. But the truth is in the Scripture, Philippians 4:13: "I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength!"

57 years ago, Boise Rescue Mission started as a small soup kitchen with just a few cots to feed and shelter homeless people. Today, the Mission operates multiple facilities in Boise and Nampa that, in FY 2013-14, were able to serve 371,811 meals and provide 127,152 nights of shelter, as well as teach the Word of God and create opportunities to recover from homelessness for hundreds of men, women, and children in need.

PROGRAMS AVAILABLE

EMERGENCY SERVICES (also called "Guest Services")

Last year the Mission provided hot meals and shelter at four locations in the Treasure Valley. A meal and a safe place to sleep is often the first step for one of our guests in the pathway to recovery from homelessness.

NEW LIFE RECOVERY PROGRAM

We continue to help those struggling with substance abuse overcome their addiction and build new, better lives.

VETERAN'S MINISTRY PROGRAM

We serve chronically homeless veterans in partnership with the VA and work to help them regain independence.

"LITTLE LIGHTS" PROGRAM FOR KIDS

We are passionate about breaking the cycle of homelessness and improving the futures of homeless children in the Treasure Valley through education, counseling, and activities.

MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM

We offer assessment, counseling and crisis management to every individual in need who comes through our doors. Through this program, men, women, and children whose lives have been damaged by their struggle with mental illness can work through their problems, achieve stability, and begin to rebuild their lives.

EDUCATION & CAREER DEVELOPMENT

We provide education, job search assistance, work ethics training, and financial accountability programs to help our guests address the root causes of their homelessness and return to society.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

We give help to more than just the homeless! Needy families and individuals in the Treasure Valley receive food assistance throughout the year along with clothing, shoes, and household items, all free of charge. During the holidays, we organize Thanksgiving and Christmas banquets and food boxes for the community, and toys for children whose families can't otherwise afford them.

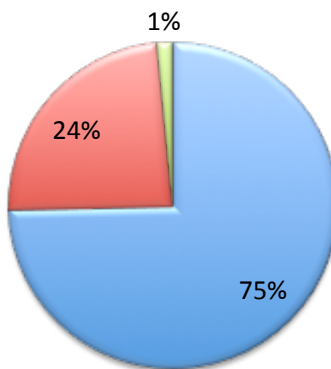

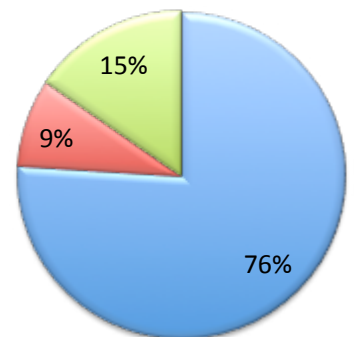
